### 1. NATURE OF ORGANIZATION

Prince Edward County Community Foundation is a not-for-profit organization, incorporated under the laws of Ontario, without share capital.

The organization works with private donors, communities and charitable organizations to stimulate charitable giving, establish permanent endowment funds, and support initiatives which make an ongoing difference in all areas of Prince Edward County.

The organization is a registered charity under the Income Tax Act of Canada, and accordingly, is not subject to income tax.

### 2. COMPARATIVE FIGURES

During the year, the organization adopted a new presentation for its revenues. As a result of the change, comparative figures for revenues and deferred revenues have been restated to reflect this presentation.

### 3. FUND BALANCES

The Organization has four funds, which comprise the following:

### **Operating Fund**

This is an unrestricted fund for the day-to-day operations of the Organization without restrictions on its use.

### **Vital Signs Project Fund**

This is a restricted fund established to facilitate and support the co-ordination of activities related to the projects of the Vital Signs Project working groups. Funds are restricted to the spending on its core areas: transportation, food security and learning.

### **Community Fund**

This is a restricted fund established to make annual grants to other charities within Prince Edward County at the discretion of the Board of Directors.
