1. NATURE OF ORGANIZATION

Prince Edward County Community Foundation is a not-for-profit organization, incorporated under the laws of Ontario, without share capital.

The organization works with private donors, communities and charitable organizations to stimulate charitable giving, establish permanent endowment funds, and support initiatives which make an ongoing difference in all areas of Prince Edward County.

The organization is a registered charity under the Income Tax Act of Canada, and accordingly, is not subject to income tax.

2. FUND BALANCES

The Organization has four funds, which comprise the following:

Operating Fund

This is an unrestricted fund for the day-to-day operations of the Organization without restrictions on its use.

Community Fund

This is a restricted fund established to make annual grants to other charities within Prince Edward County at the discretion of the Board of Directors.

Managed Funds

This is a restricted fund where the funds are held by the Organization on behalf of the donors. Funds are restricted and the income and capital is designated for the distribution at the direction of the donor. At year end, funds held for others are comprised of the following at market value:
