The Municipal Community Grants Program supports Prince Edward County in the areas of arts & culture, heritage, recreation, environment, health and human services. Applications will be accepted from **February 12**th **to March 18**th **at noon**. Applicants will be notified of the outcome of their application before end of May.

Who is eligible?

- Not-for-profit organizations and community groups that support and provide programs and services in the following areas: arts and culture, heritage, recreation, environment, health and human services.
- Places of worship that have partnerships and use space for open community activities and groups. The programming is to be non-denominational and inclusive.
- Priority will be given to projects that align with the strategies of the Municipality and The County Foundation such as:
 - Vital Signs
 - Community Safety and Well-being Plan
 - Thrive PEC Community Economies Pilot Proiect
 - o Strategic Priorities of Council

School boards; for-profit businesses; service clubs; sectarian or political entities; and individuals are **not** eligible.

Total Available Funding

- \$129,716 (Grants over \$5,000)
- \$16,615 (Grants under \$5,000)

Municipal Community Grants Program will not fund any projects/groups under the following circumstances:

- The funding is considered primary and/or covers operation costs for day-to-day administration of the program of more than 20%.
- Activity takes place outside of PEC;
- Grant is to fund a deficit or funding shortfall;
- Application and component pieces are deemed to be incomplete;
- Any previously granted funds are not fully reconciled and all reports received;
- Applicant does not meet eligibility criteria;
- Annual fund drives and fundraising activities for sustaining support;
- The organization does not meet <u>General</u> <u>Granting Conditions</u> set out by TCF.
